The aim is to meet the needs of learners who wish to work and develop a career within the sport and active leisure sector. At level 1 Learners will be encouraged to participate in a wide range of sport and active leisure activities. The level 2 course will give learners a solid foundation in the sector, enabling them to develop essential skills required for gaining employment, securing career progression, or progressing to further qualifications and training required to achieve their career aspirations.

During this course, you will

Animal and Land based studies

What will I do?

The animal and land based course will be over 5 lessons a week and is an excellent option to take if you are interested in a career in this industry. The course provides opportunities to develop a range of skills and techniques, personal qualities and attitudes essential for a successful career.

This course is aimed at individuals with an interest in Animal Care who may require some support in achieving their career aims. Students will have the opportunity to develop knowledge and practical skills in Animal Care alongside the more general skills required to gain employment or to continue in training.

Time will be split between classroom activities and practical work in the Animal Care Centre. The programme has been designed to improve literacy skills, spoken communication, numeracy, IT, problem solving, personal development and team work skills.
